

ORDER

The Court has received Plaintiff's Response to Recreation by Design, LLC's Motion in Limine Requesting that the Court Enter its Prior Rulings Made in the *Alexander* Bellwether Trial as to Certain Similar Evidentiary Issues (Rec. Doc. 13606), wherein Plaintiff stipulates to Defendant's request that this Court adopt the Alexander rulings described in Rec.
