

ORDER AND REASONS

Because the Court determines that the request for dismissal of Coachmen Industries, Inc. ("Coachmen") is premature,¹ **IT IS ORDERED** that **the 12(B)(2) Motion to Dismiss Coachmen Industries, Inc. For Lack of Personal Jurisdiction Adopting Previously-Filed 12(B)(2) Motion [Rec. Doc. 213] (Rec. Doc. 784)** is **DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** to the right of Coachmen to re-assert these arguments in a separate motion, if necessary, when such arguments are raised by other defendants.
